

BOYCE HILL GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS**
 - a) Beyond any hedge or fence bounding the course.
 - b) Beyond any line of white posts.
 - b) 6th hole: to the right of Tee defined by white posts.
 - c) Over the ditch between 6th/7th fairways up to and including the ditch crossing the 7th fairway.
 - c) 12th hole: left of white posts dividing 8, 9, 10 and 11th from the 12th.
 - d) 13th hole: over the ditch dividing 13th/16th fairways, between white posts.
 - e) 16th hole: over the ditch dividing 16th/13th fairways, between white posts.
2. **STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 24-1)**
Stones in bunkers are deemed to be movable obstructions.
3. **PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES (Rule 24-2)**
Young trees either staked or surrounded by tree guards which interfere with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with Rule 24-2b(i). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
4. **OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 24-2)**
Paths and water hazard posts shall be treated as Immovable Obstructions. All fixed sprinkler heads are Immovable Obstructions. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green, but not in a hazard and an Immovable Obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows: the ball must be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay that (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be cleaned when lifted.
5. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25-1)**
Play is prohibited from all areas of GUR. If a player's ball lies in such an area or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of their intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 25-1.

6. DRAINAGE LINES

Drainage lines are defined as abnormal ground conditions. Where interference occurs with the lie of the ball relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 25-1.

Where interference occurs with a player's stance, it is deemed not to be, of itself, interference under this rule.

7. DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES

The use of distance-measuring devices for the purpose of assessing distance only is permitted, strictly in accordance with Rule 14-3.

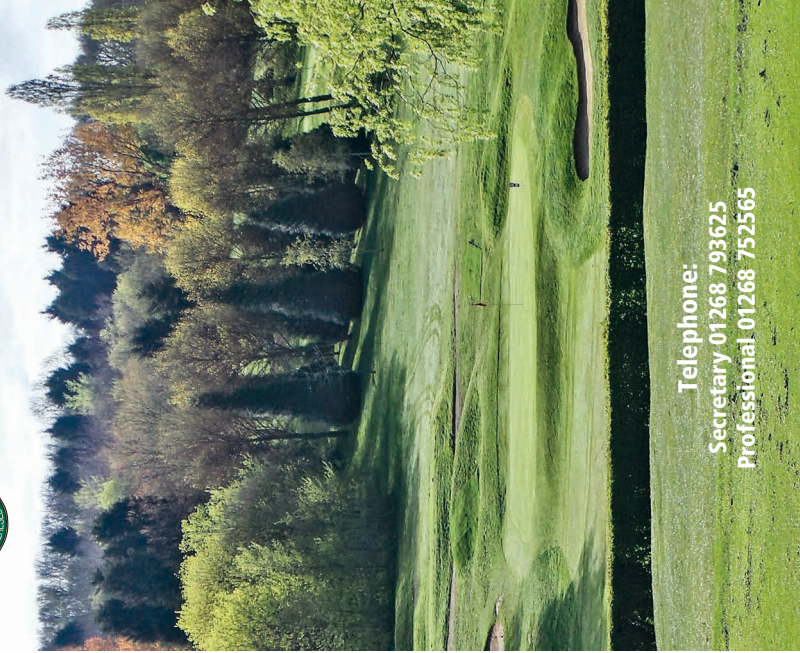
8. PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES:
